The regatta is open to all St. Maarten/St. Martin Schools entering in Optimist, Laser, Rs Zest and RS Quests classes.

4.2. Entrants are not required to pay an entry fee courtesy of Domino's Pizza.

4.3 Boats will be equally divided among the schools by the SMYC sailing instructors

### 5. Registration

Registration is required at 9.00 am Sat 15<sup>th</sup> January at the SMYC.

### 6. Race areas

Racing will be in the lagoon near the airport runway, next to the causeway bridge or outside in the Simpson Bay.

### 7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration and online at the Regatta website before Friday 14<sup>th</sup> of January

### 8. Scoring

8.1. When fewer than 5 races have been completed a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

8.2. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boats series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8.3. Scoring will be by the CHIPS – 3 High point System which awards scores based on class size.

### 9. Prizes

9.1. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each class.

9.2. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd school team based on the total weighted score of the 3 highest scoring entries per school.

9.3. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee and/or Organizer.
