1. Entry

- 1.1. Any entry into any of the series that constitute this championship will constitute an entry into the Championship.
- 1.2. Entry fees may be paid per race day or for the entire season. Entry fee is per boat entry.
- 1.3. Boats can enter online on <https://www.smyc.com/dinghy-series> Dinghy Series page or by emailing saskia@smyc.com
2. All further information or amendments will be published at www.smyc.com/dinghy-series and on the notice board at the Sint Maarten Yacht Club. Changes to the sailing instructions can also be given verbally by the Race Officer on the water.
3. Courses will be a mixture of windward-leeward and composite courses starting and finishing in or near Simpson Bay or Simpson Bay Lagoon.

5. Scoring

- 5.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 5.2 Low-point scoring will apply.
- 5.3 The final score of each entrant will be made up of the total final scores in each of the constituent events.
- 5.4 A boat series score will be the total of her race scores excluding the worst score when five races are completed. When less than five races are completed there will be no discard.
- 5.5 For the Laser class handicaps will be calculated to allow entries with standard, radial or 4.7 sails.

6. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in each class at the end of each individual series. A Championship crew will be awarded the Grant Thornton Season Championship to the winner of the class in which it is judged that the most convincing win was achieved in the most competitive class.
