### 1. Entry

- 1.1. Any entry into any of the series that constitute this championship will constitute an entry into the Championship.

### 2. Scoring

- 2.1 The final score of each entrant will be made up of the total final scores in each of the constituent events.
- 2.2 An entrant not competing in any of the series will be scored with number of registered entries plus one.
- 2.3 A boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding the worst score when five events are completed . When less than five events are completed there will be no discard

### 3. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in each class at the end of each individual series. A Championship crew will be awarded the Grant Thornton Season Championship to the winner of the class in which it is judged that the most convincing win was achieved in the most competitive class.
